32 pistol shooters came out in the morning and shot 106 rounds (without missing) on four courses.

- Classifier "Colorblind" - CM 99-43 (18 Rounds)
- 25 Yard North (28 round field course with a clam shell and a swinger triggered by an activator pad)
- 50 yard (26 round course of fire that required the shooters to engage targets as far out as 35 yards or a running field course engaging targets close up)
- LE range (32 Round field course with a steel activated twister and a an activator pad triggered clam shell and swinger)

7 rifle and 8 shotgun shooters signed up for the afternoon of two rifle (58 rounds combined) and one 17 round shotgun stages.

2006 Election

- **Board of Directors Elections**

There are seven seats on the Millcreek PSL Board of Directors that you will be voting on for 2006. The assignments of roles and responsibilities of each board member will be defined at the first meeting of the new BOD.

You will have number of vote shares equal to the number of matches that you either shot or contributed to in 2005 (i.e., score keeping or member of 2005 BOD) for each position. This means that if you shot at all 11 matches to date in 2005 (January – November), you will have 11 votes times 7 seats for total of 77 votes. If you participated in 5 matches, your vote shares would be 35 (5 Matches X 7 Seats).

You can use these votes in any way that you want – spread them evenly across the 7 candidates that you desire, or concentrate on one or few members that you want to see serving on the board.

- **Amendments to the Club Bylaws**

There are two amendments to the club's bylaws that you will be voting on. You will vote yes or no on whether the following changes are acceptable. The two issues are:

- o Elimination of the requirement to issue certificates of membership of the club members from the bylaws. (See strike out text in Section 1 below)
- o Addition of membership requirements to the bylaws. (Section 3)

You will have number of vote shares equal to the number of matches that you either shot or contributed to in 2005 (i.e., score keeping or member of 2005 BOD).

Proposed Bylaws Amendment
ARTICLE VI
MEMBERSHIPS AND THEIR TRANSFER

~~SECTION 1. Memberships. Memberships with the Corporation shall be in such form as shall be determined by the Board of Directors. The certificates of membership shall be signed by the President and by the Secretary or by such other officers authorized by law and by the Board of Directors so to do, and sealed with the corporate seal. All memberships shall be consecutively numbered or otherwise identified. The name and address of the person to whom the membership is issued, with the number of membership votes and date of issue, shall be entered on the membership books of the Corporation. All certificates surrendered to the Corporation for transfer shall be cancelled. In case of a lost, destroyed or mutilated certificate a new one may be issued therefore upon such terms and indemnity of the Corporation as the Board of Directors may prescribe.~~

SECTION 2. Transfer of Memberships. Transfer of memberships with the Corporation shall not be made. A member desiring to withdraw from membership in the Corporation shall surrender his membership certificate to the Secretary of the Corporation. The person in whose name the membership stands on the books of the Corporation shall be deemed by the Corporation to be the owner thereof for all purposes.

SECTION 3. Membership Requirements. All members of the Corporation will also hold current membership in the National Rifle Association. As a condition of membership, in addition to yearly dues, all prospective and renewing members will contribute in some significant manner to the operation of the corporation. The contribution may normally be fulfilled by the construction of two Courses of Fire each calendar year, or some other significant contribution approved by the Board of Directors. Those failing to contribute to the operation of the corporation will not receive vote shares at the annual meeting, voting rights at the annual or any other meeting, or members' discounts on matches, materials or club events.

The underlined section denotes a proposed addition to the bylaws, and requires a simple majority to pass. The struck through portion denotes a proposed deletion from the bylaws, and requires a simple majority to pass.

- **Proxy vote**
If you cannot attend the December election in person, you can assign your votes to a proxy. A proxy will cast vote shares on your behalf. You will need to contact a member who will be attending the meeting and provide him/her with your voting instructions. You will then need to contact John Espy in writing (email is acceptable as long as all parties are properly addressed/copied) with the proxy assignment no later than Monday, December 5.
- **Outcome of all election activities will be announced on December 10.**

End of Year Celebration

As in the years past, we will be celebrating the end of year with a cook-out, swap meet, and door prizes. For those of you that have been around a few years, it will be very similar in format to last couple years...

- **Food**
The MPSL club will provide the food (burgers, brats, potato salad) and beverages. If you have a special dish or dessert that you want to share with the membership they will certainly be welcome.
- **Swap Meet**
Bring out the shooting stuff that have accumulated in closets and basements that you want to sell. The tables need to be set up on the front part of the clubhouse (so that they don't get confused with the door prizes)
- **Door Prizes**
There will be two sets of door prizes. To participate in the first prize, bring something to the table that is worth at least \$10. You will get a ticket and be eligible to pick up something from the same table when your number gets called.
The second set of prizes will be drawings for some guns. At the time of publication, the details are still being worked out. To be eligible for the gun drawings, you must have participated in a regular club match in 2005, prior to the December match. The chances of winning will increase with the number of matches shot in 2005.
You must be present to participate in the door prize events. Winners of the gun drawings must follow all local, state and Federal regulations regarding transfer of firearms.

NRA Membership

As part of shooting at the Millcreek Rifle Club range, it is required that all MPSL members also belong to the NRA. Please bring a copy of your NRA publication with the address label or a NRA membership card as a proof of current membership when you renew MPSL membership for 2005.

You can renew your NRA membership at a special pricing through the club.
