## April Pistol Notes

- The pistol stages need to be ready for a 9 AM walkthrough. If you are responsible for setting up a stage, please make every effort to show up as soon as the gates open at 7 AM. If you have not started setting up by 7:30 it may be assumed that you're a no show and alternate plans will be made.
- As the RO, come prepared with a course design in mind. The Match Director will work with you to create a challenging and safe course of fire but come with some ideas.
- Guests from Ft Leavenworth will be returning for more shooting at the April match. Please make them feel welcome.
- If the weather is as nice as it was in March, we can expect another record turn out. This means we all have to do our part in keeping the squads moving (scoring, pasting, setting steel and picking up magazines and brass for all shooters in the squad)

## April Long Gun Notes

- For the Rifle stages in April, the High Power range is available to from noon to 5 PM. Please plan on using it. If we do not use it, we will lose it.
- In designing the Shotgun courses, please set up steel and paper as separate arrays of targets – shoot all paper (slugs), move/reload and shoot all steel (shot) or vise-versa. Set-up of steel and paper mixed in a single array presents an opportunity to accidentally send a slug into steel, an automatic DQ and a safety issue for the range.

- This year, a strong focus will be placed on shooting fundamentals with new and newer shooters.
- The match fee will be \$15.

The total count for March was 76 shooters. This included 26 guests from Fort Leavenworth and 50 regular members and other guests. There were 25 long gun shooters in the afternoon.

### Pistol – 108 rounds

- 24 round Classifier Quickly II (CM99-13) – a Virginia Count course set up by Stephen Schrader
- 29 round course on 25 Yard North Range with Texas Star, swinger and a pair of double bobbbers-- set up by Jesse Wood. The double bobbbers are the latest addition to the club's inventory of moving targets.
- 30 round track meet set up by Ray Conrad and John Aull on the 50 Yard Range
- Saving Sara Rambo, another track meet (25 round field course) set up by Craig Cigard on the LE Range with a lot of movement. Like all past Sara Rambo stages, the shooter had to pick up/rescue the doll and move it from point A to point B during the course of fire.

- To ensure that we have all stages covered throughout the year, the ARO slots cannot be opened up until the RO slots are all full. Exceptions may be granted based on the member's level of experience.

### First time setting up?

Concerned about setting up a course as a RO? If this is your first time, let the Match Director know and he will help you create a quality course of fire. What the club needs to fill the RO slots are persons taking responsibility to get the work done. If you can follow instructions of the Match Director and have the physical ability to haul targets and props, you have all the basic qualifications.

### RO Class

Eastern Nebraska Gun Club has a Level 1 RO class scheduled for June 24th. and 25th. The cost of the class will be dependant on how many people sign up. The first day is 8am-5pm. of class time, the second day is range time and will be incorporated into our match that day. The cost should be around \$45-\$65 and will include the cost of your lunch and entry fees to the match on the second day.
