June Pistol Notes

- **The pistol stages need to be ready for a 9 AM walkthrough. If you are responsible for setting up a stage, please make every effort to show up as soon as the gates open at 7 AM.** If you have not started setting up by 7:30 it may be assumed that you're a no show and alternate plans will be made.
- **As the RO, come prepared with a course design in mind.** The Match Director will work with you to create a challenging and safe course of fire but come with some ideas.
- **We had one DQ in May.** This was an experienced shooter who lost his footing on the 50 yard Range and broke 180 as he tried to maintain his balance. While no one was hurt, it made the people who saw it happen duck for cover. This is a reminder to all to watch your muzzle.

June Long Gun Notes

- **Long guns are going to use USPSA Divisions!** You will need to declare division according to these rules (see Appendix D US Divisions) <http://www.uspsa.org/rules/2004RifleRulesFinal.pdf>
 - **Rifle Divisions**
 - OPEN RIFLE -- More than One Scope/Bipod/Ported Barrel and Big Comps allowed
 - TACTICAL RIFLE -- Only One scope and Small Comps (max of 3" length x 1" diameter) allowed. No Bipods/No Ports/No Prototypes
 - STD RIFLE -- Only Small Comps (max of 3" length x 1" diameter) allowed -- No Scopes/No Bipods/No Ports/No Prototypes
 - Manual OPEN -- 5 Rds Max/Manual Action
 - Manual STD -- 5 Rds Max/Manual Action/NO Ports/NO Bipods/NO Comps/No Prototypes
 - **Shotgun Divisions**
 - OPEN -- Max capacity of 11 rounds/Detachable Mags/Speed Loaders/Ports, Comps & Bipods allowed
 - STANDARD -- Max capacity of 9 rounds, NO Comps/NO Ports/No Bipods/No Speed Loaders/No Detachable Mags/No Prototypes
- For the Rifle stages in June, the High Power range will be available from noon to 5 PM. Please plan on using it. If we do not use it, we will lose it.
- **Randy Atherton has indicated that his shotgun course in June will be birdshot only.**

Scoring

- A reminder that you need to make a habit of **checking the score sheet** and making sure that your hits are recorded properly and legibly. After you shoot, you can and should ask to see your scores!
- The score keeper will only tabulate what is legible on paper. He cannot psychically decipher illegible writing or missing scores! This will serve you well, if you are at a match where more than simple bragging rights among your friends are at stake.

The Next Skills Development Match is Sunday June 4

- The club will be hosting a series of Skills Development Matches on first Sundays in June, August, September and October on the LE Range.
- This year, a strong focus will be placed on shooting fundamentals with new and newer shooters.
- The match fee will be \$15 for members/\$25 for guests.
- Come prepared with a **reliable gun AND at least 100 rounds of reliable ammo**, suitable holster and a minimum of three magazines.
- These sessions start at 8AM (sign up complete by 9AM) and will finish between noon and 1PM.
- The more experienced shooters are welcome to come and assist.

Still Open Slots for Area 3 Championship on June 15 –18th

- Match fees for registrations postmarked by May 31, 2006 is \$125. After May 31, it is \$150.

Larry Bullock Benefit Match is Sunday, July 2
