- **Long Gun Shooters** – We have the 500 Yard Range starting at Noon on the match date.

MPSL Membership Requirements

Recently there have been several incidences where members failed to set up their course of fire, without advance notice or valid reasons. Please remember that as a club, we all voted in the rules regarding member responsibilities (357 vs. 26 vote shares) at the last election:

- To be a member in good standing and be eligible to participate at member rates, one must sign up to set up two courses of fire during the year.
- Alternative means for providing service to the club in lieu of setting up two courses were also covered. If you wish to provide service in some other way, you must present your request in writing to the BOD for approval.
- If you have circumstances that prevent you from fulfilling your requirements on your own, it is first up to you to find a suitable substitute. If your substitute sets up for you, your obligations are met... Any method of compensation for your substitute will be between you and your back-up.

NRA Membership

As part of the privilege of shooting at the Millcreek Rifle Club range, all MPSL members must belong to the NRA.

Please bring a copy of your NRA publication with the address label or your NRA membership card as a proof of current membership when you renew MPSL membership for 2007.
