### Shooters Meeting (10:00 am)

**Pistol Match** - Four Pistol Stages including a Classifier will be shot in the morning with two Rifle stages and one Shotgun stage in the afternoon.

Also, make note that there must be a pistol and rifle match director signed up for each monthly match. If either slot is not filled at least two weeks prior to the match then that match will not be held. For example: if someone signs up to be the Rifle Match Director but nobody signs up to be Pistol Match Director then we will not have a pistol match.

Please sign up for an RO slot (one per membership year), there are slots open towards the end of year. **Also, remember that we should all try to get to the range at 8:00 or soon thereafter to help get everything set up.** We have had very good and challenging stages this past year and we all want to keep that going.

**If you have a conflict preventing you from setting up on a match day**, be sure find someone to fill in for you. You can always send a message to the communications e-mail address on the website ([communications@millcreekpsl.org](mailto:communications@millcreekpsl.org)) and your request will be forwarded to the members. However, this is not a guarantee; you are responsible for finding someone to do your setup.

- All Shooters – **“PRINT”** legibly on your score sheet – provide all your information (Division, Minor/Major, USPSA #).
  - If no data is available, you will be scored in the highest scoring division possible for the score sheet and shooting minor – i.e., the yellow sheets (for Limited/L-10) will be scored as Limited/Minor.
  - **MAKE SURE YOUR SCORE SHEETS ARE PUT IN THE PLASTIC BOX IN THE SHED. IF NOT THEN YOU MAY BE SCORED AS DNF FOR THOSE STAGES.**

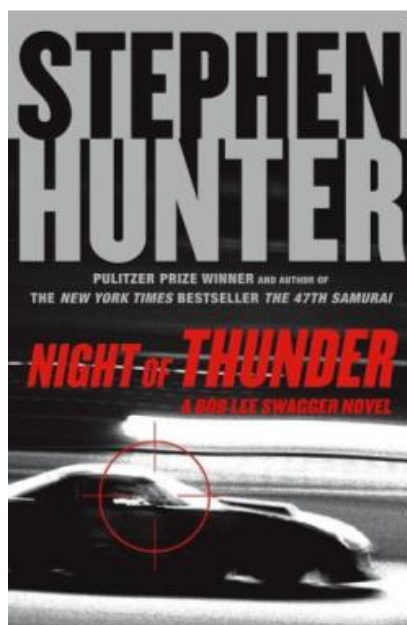
