We still need RO's for the rifle and shotgun stage. Please ask to sign up for an RO slot at the next match. We apparently have several slots still open for November. If you want to set up in nice weather then you should hurry and get signed up right away. **Also, remember that we should all try to get to the range at 7:00 or as soon thereafter as possible to help get everything set up.** We have had very good and challenging stages the past year and we all want to keep that going.

If you have a conflict preventing you from setting up on a match day, be sure find someone to fill in for you. If you do not know anyone at all, you can always send a reply all to the match announcement email and ASK for help.

October Match Notes

- The Classifier will be set up on the LE range. Depending on the complexity of the Classifier, an additional speed course may also be established on that range.
- We are using the 50 yard range again.
- If you are setting up the Classifier, you need to make certain that everything is properly measured. We can only submit the scores to USPSA for classification if all the measurements meet the stage diagram.
- All Shooters – Write LEGIBLY on your score sheet – Provide All your information (Division, Minor/Major, USPSA #). If no data is available, you will be scored in the highest scoring division possible for the score sheet and shooting minor – i.e., the gold/yellow sheets (for Limited/L-10) will be scored as Limited/Minor. **MAKE SURE YOUR SCORE SHEETS ARE PUT IN THE PLASTIC BOX IN THE SHED. IF NOT THEN YOU MAY BE SCORED AS DNF FOR THOSE STAGES.**

 - Watch that your trigger finger is outside the trigger guard when moving and reloading.
 - You cannot “load and make ready” until given the order by the RO.
