 - **MAKE SURE YOUR SCORE SHEETS ARE PUT IN THE PLASTIC BOX IN THE SHED. IF NOT THEN YOU MAY BE SCORED AS DNF FOR THOSE STAGES.**

McKaig Challenge 300 Meter Side Match

This is a side match which will be scored separately from the other stages and you can use a different rifle for the McKaig Challenge if you want to. In the McKaig challenge, all rifles and calibers will be scored together, in other words, there is no distinction for caliber, scope or open sights, etc.

Each shooter will be given 3 minutes to shoot 15 rounds at a standard

IPSC target placed 300 meters down range (Virginia count-15 rounds only). Hits to the torso A zone will count 5 points each. Hits to B, C, and D zones will be scored as usual.

The first five Hits to the head A zone will count 10 points each, additional hit to the head A zone will count 5 points each. Each shooter can support the forend of their firearm with a bipod OR sand bags, (etc.), but not the butt of the firearm. Only one type of forend support please. You may want to bring a matt to shoot on (we will have rugs to use too) as well as a spotting scope to verify your hits/misses as wind and mirage can play havoc with bullet drift. There should be some extra spotting scopes available to use, but no guarantees.

Try and bring 15 rounds to the shooting line and ONLY 15 rounds to the

shooting line to avoid extra shots (which are penalized). However you are responsible for your own ammo management. A scoped rifle is recommended but since all shooters are lumped together it can be fun to see how well you can do with open iron sights against those with scopes.
